Steps to success:

- Include powerful adjectives to describe inside tomb and how feel.
- Include what you will do with your discovery

<u>Challenge</u>: Challenge yourself to include present perfect tense (have or has)

Artefacts for Sale!

Make a poster advertising an ancient Egyptian artefact of your choice.

Steps to success:

- Use persuasive language (including rhetorical questions and expanded noun phrases)
- Write neatly
- Eye catching illustration of your product

<u>Challenge:</u> Include a fact about the purpose of the artefact

Inside a Pyramid

Make a model of the inside of a pyramid.

Ask your teacher for examples.

Steps to success:

- Research what was normally put kept inside pyramids
- Label the different parts of the pyramid

<u>Challenge:</u> Include an explanation of why some of the artefacts were included in the pyramid.

How to Mummify a Pharaoh

Write instructions for mummifying a Pharaoh. Do not forget to include illustrations to make sure your instructions are clear enough to follow.

Steps to success:

- Make sure your instructions are in chronological order!
- Include list of equipment needed

<u>Challenge:</u> Challenge yourself by using fronted adverbials of time to order your instructions.

Tomb Raiders



Create a Hieroglyph Mat

Create your own hieroglyph mat to help people write in ancient Egyptian.

Steps to success:

- Write neatly
- Make sure your symbols are clearly drawn.

Make a Canopic Jar

Make a canopic jar to store all the important organs for your mummy. Do not forget to label the jar with hieroglyphs because they will need them in the afterlife!

Steps to success:

- Write out label in English before finding the hieroglyph that represent them
- Make sure your symbols are clearly drawn

Make an Amulet

Make a salt dough Egyptian amulet. Ask your teacher for examples of amulets.

Recipe: You will need Salt, Flour and Water

- .. Combine the flour and salt in a large mixing bowl.
- Gradually add water while stirring and mixing to form a dough with a Play-Doh like consistency.
- 3. Form the dough into a ball and knead for approximately 5-7 minutes, until the dough is smooth and firm. Additional water may be needed, depending upon humidity. Add a teaspoon of water at a time until the dough reaches the proper texture. On the other hand, if the dough is too sticky, add more flour by the teaspoon until it's no longer tacky.
- 4. Store the salt dough in a Ziploc bag when it's not in use to prevent it from drying out.

Steps to success:

- Research types of amulets
- Decorate with bold colours
